BRIEF INFORMATION

Borobudur temple is the largest Buddhist temple in the world; the biggest ancient monument sanctuary is one of the jewels of the UNESCO world culture heritage. A vast Buddhist monument in form of mandala that symbolized the cosmology of the universe in Buddha teachings, this magnificent building is divided into three levels, namely the world of desire or lust (Kamadhatu), the world of form (Rupadhatu) and the world without any form (Arupadhatu). It was built in the heart of Java around 9th century by the Sailendra dynasty. Borobudur consists of 6 terraces, 3 circular platforms which decorated with 2,672 relief panels and 504 Buddha statues. The top of the temple consist of 1 main stupa which located in the middle of the platform and surrounded by 72 stupas. American news channel CNN stated Borobudur at sunrise, Java Indonesia ranked as the number one in the list of "27 must-sees on this incredible planet"

The temple opened everyday including public holiday with operational hour from 6 am - 5 pm

Museum Karmawibangga

Museum Karmawibangga displays a variety of information about Borobudur's history, archaeology, architecture, environment, etc. Diverse artefacts found around Borobudur also actively displayed in this museum.



Museum Samudraraksa

One of two museums that located in the area of Borobudur Park. This museum became the last stop of Borobudur Ship or Samudraraksa Ship who have sailed the Indian Ocean to the African region. The Cinnamon Route is the name of this expedition. This challenging and risky journey had been proven by brave people, tracing the ancient route to bring the knowledge from the past to the future. A relief of the ship engraved on the wall of Borobudur Temple, was brought into a real.

Tourist Train

Andong Tour

This tour brings you traveling around villages by local transportation called Andhong or horse cart. Along the the trip can be seen beautiful sceneries and rural living. Borobudur Sunrise

it offers a different experience where participants were given a special pass to enter the monument early in the morning at approximately 04.30 am before public visitors and visitor have to walk from the Manohara Hotel to Borobudur with a pre-dawn stroll through the dewy grass of a lush tropical garden. Vesak

Set in the night sky and the full moon, thousands of reddish yellow paper lanterns into the air to deliver the prayers. This is a very fantastic moment at once sacred and full of impressions in a series of Vesak celebrations. This moment is the culmination of the celebration of Vesak, which is annually held in Borobudur.



Mahakarya Borobudur

The Spectacular show that takes you on a sensory odyssey through magnificent performance of light and sound and 250 Javanese traditional dancers. You will be flash back in history during a time when this ancient wonder of the world was once center of powerful kingdom. The Masterpiece of Mahakarya Borobudur Colossal Dance Performance, the only great colossal only held 1 (one) or 2 (two) times in a year at Taman Aksobya open theater located in the foot of Borobudur at about 50 meters to the main temple.

HOW TO GET BOROBUDUR TEMPLE

Adi Sucipto International Airport (Yogyakarta) - Borobudur

Distance to Borobudur is about 46 KM (\pm 1 hour drive), it could be reached by taxi/cab or renting a car at the airport. Other option is by using public transport (minibus) route Yogyakarta - Borobudur through Jombor bus station. The departure frequency is between 1-1 ½ hours. Minibus operates from 06.00-17.00 local time. To reach Jombor Bus Station, visitors could use Transjogja from Adi Sucipto International Airport

Tugu Railway Station (Yogyakarta) - Borobudur

Distance to Borobudur is about 42 KM (\pm 50 minutes drive). it could be reached by taxi/cab or renting a car at the airport. Other option is by using public transport (minibus) route Yogyakarta - Borobudur through Jombor bus station. The departure frequency is between 1-1 ½ hours. Minibus operates from 06.00-17.00 local time. To reach Jombor bus station, visitors could use Transjogja (Mangkubumi Shelter) near to station.

Jombor Bus Station (Yogyakarta) - Borobudur

Distance to Borobudur is about 40 KM (\pm 40 minutes drive). The departure frequency is between 1-1 ½ hours. Minibus operates from 06.00-17.00 local time

Tour guides at Borobudur temple is available in Indonesian, English, Mandarin, Korean, Japanese, Dutch, French, Spanish and German. To get a tour guide service, visitors could contact the ticketing officers.
