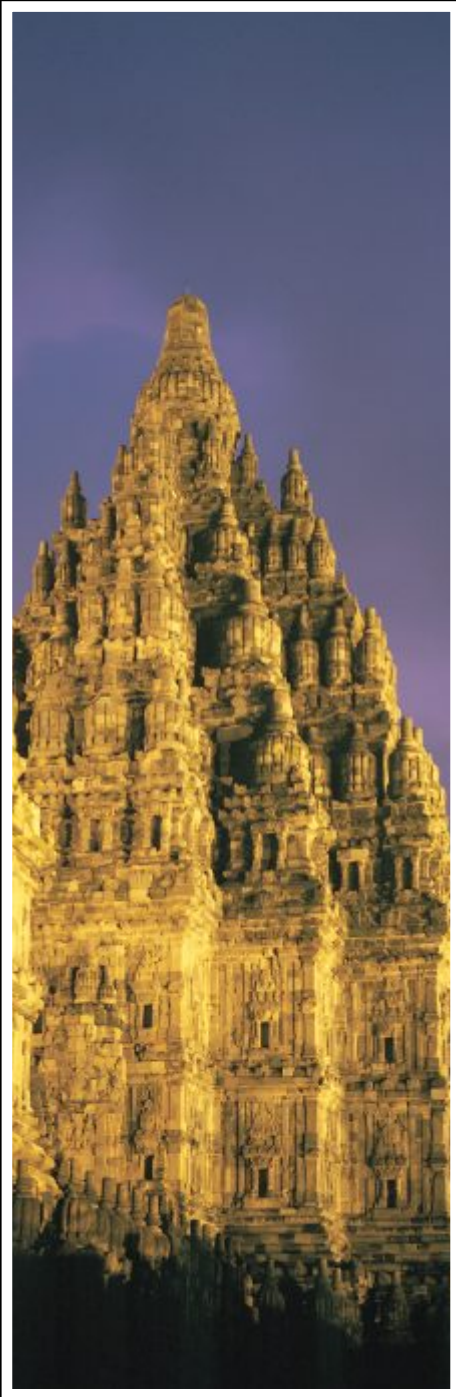

BRIEF EXPLANATION

Prambanan is the tallest and the most beautiful temple in the world, of the UNESCO world cultural heritage. Built in the 9th century, this is the biggest temple complex in Java with three main temples dedicated to the three great Hindu divinities, Shiva, Vishnu, and Brahma, the symbols of Trimurti in Hindu belief. Around Prambanan Park, was located Sewu Temple Complex, Lumbung Temple and Buraah Temple

Archaeological Museum & Audio Visual



The Museum has great archeological remains found at Prambanan and its adjacent area. Its collections consists of ceramics, sculptures, inscriptions and architectural elements of the temple. Documentary films on Prambanan Temple complex is available at the audio visual room located next to the museum.

POINT OF INTEREST

Sewu Temple Complex



Within the Prambanan Park, 800 metres north of the Hindu Prambanan temples is the Candi Sewu Complex and is the second largest Buddhist temple in Java, Borobudur bring the largest. The name Sewu Temple means 1000 temples, in fact this complex has 253 building structures.

Bubrah Temple



Bubrah Temple is ruins of a Buddhist Temple. This Temple was built at about 9th century AD.

Lumbung Temple



Candi Lumbung is a Buddhist temple built around 850AD by the Mataram Dynasty, which consists of a ruin of a main temple surrounded by 16 smaller temples, called Perwaras Temple.



POINT OF INTEREST

Ramayana Ballet



This performance is a marvelous visualization of legendary epos and able to unite various Javanese arts such as dance, drama and music on one stage and one momentum to present the Ramayana story.

Perform every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday (7.30 PM - 9.30 PM)

November - April perform at Trimurti Theatre (Indoor stage)

May - October perform at Ramayana Open Stage Theatre (outdoor stage)

Tawur Agung



Every once a year Prambanan Temple host the Tawur Agung Ceremony, an important and beautiful Hindus ritual held on the Eve of Nyepi in which the evil spirit are sacred away by a ceremony of offerings, blessings and ritual

HOW TO GET THERE

Adi Sutjipto International Airport (Yogyakarta) - Prambanan Temple

Distance to Prambanan \pm 7,6 KM or about 10 minutes drive. Can be reached by taxi/cab or rent a car from the airport. Another option using public transportation, TransJogja. From Adi Sutjipto Airport Shelter take TransJogja route 1A to Prambanan Temple.

Tugu Yogyakarta Train Station (Yogyakarta) - Prambanan Temple

Distance to Prambanan \pm 17 KM or about 40 minutes drive. Can be reached by taxi/cab or rent a car from the Tugu Train Station. Another option using public transportation, TransJogja. From Mangkubumi 1 Shelter take TransJogja route 1A to Prambanan Temple.

Prambanan Shelter, Adi Sutjipto International Airport, Tugu Train Station, Malioboro (Shopping downtown), JEC (Vice versa).
